

Council Tax Exemption: PhD students writing up a thesis

From October 2013, PhD students who are writing up their thesis are not registered as full-time students. They are no longer required to be resident in Aberystwyth or to study on a full-time basis and many will go into full-time employment while completing their thesis. The University does not, therefore, provide automatic exemption from Council Tax to full-time PhD students after their registration period ends. Instead, they will be liable to pay Council Tax depending on the amount of time they spend on their thesis.

If you have been studying full time before your writing up year and will be working on your thesis full time (at least 21 hours per week for at least 24 weeks of the academic year) during the 12 month period immediately following the end of your full time registration period you will be eligible for council tax exemption. Before your exemption can be confirmed with Ceredigion County Council, you will need to provide confirmation from your supervisor and Institute that you will be studying full time, using the form available at:

If you do not live within Ceredigion, your local council may require further supporting evidence that you meet the requirements for exemption.

Students writing up their thesis will be liable for council tax in the following scenarios:

- If they take up full-time employment at the same time as writing the thesis
- If they were registered previously as a part-time student
- If they will not be working on their thesis full time during the writing up year.

Application for Council Tax Exemption from PhD Students in their first year of writing up who were previously full time and who are resident in Ceredigion, applicable from October 2013.

This application should be signed by the primary University Supervisor and a representative of the student's Institute. Only PhD students who are in their first twelve months of writing-up, who were full time students while under supervised study, and who reside in Ceredigion, should complete this form, which requests exemption from Council Tax during this 12 month period only. Should this request not be approved the student will be notified by Academic Quality and Records Office.
